I further agree to report and pay the inspection fee of \$0.45 (45 cents) per 100 pounds within 30 days after the close of each quarter ending the last day of November, February, May and August.

I have read and am familiar with the provisions of the Texas Seed Law and Regulations and agree to comply with all provisions of said law and all rules and regulations established thereunder.
