TDA is extending the application deadline for the Downtown Revitalization Program from April 3 to April 7.

2026 Downtown Revitalization Program, including Main Street Set-Aside (CDM)

Purpose: The TxCDBG Downtown Revitalization Program provides funding for infrastructure improvements to promote pedestrian-centered economic activity.

Eligible municipalities may apply to address slum and blighted conditions in the downtown district – these projects most commonly include sidewalk and lighting improvements. Applicant communities that qualify as predominantly low- to moderate-income may apply for other downtown improvements to support pedestrian-based economic activity.

Maximum Grant Amount: \$1,000,000
Community Application Deadline: **April 7, 2026**
