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## Updated Form: A400 BABA Compliance Form

Based on additional information and clarification of BABA requirements from HUD, TDA has updated the Form A400 BABA Compliance Form.

- Form A400 now requires the Grant Recipient to identify all materials subject to BABA requirements, even those currently exempted under the current HUD Phased Implementation waiver.
- Options for classifying each item now include:
  - Select "Attached" when submitting the Manufacturer's Certification.
  - Select "Submitted" for subsequent payment requests where the Manufacturer's Certification is already on file with TDA.
  - Select "No, Exempted Phase" if the material is exempted under the HUD Phased Implementation requirements outlined in Chapter 4.
  - Select "No, 5%" if a material is subject to the BABA requirements as outlined in Chapter 4, and the Grant Recipient has designated this material under the de minimus waiver (I.e., less than 5% of total covered material costs, no additional documentation required for BABA compliance).

Note: the 5% de minimus exemption will now be calculated based on all of the reported materials, rather than only those materials covered by the current HUD Phased Implementation requirements.

- Reminder: The items reported are materials / supplies as purchased by the construction contractor (or entity approved for force account construction methods).
- For communities needing assistance with classifying materials, the <u>Texas Water Development</u> <u>Board has published guidance</u> that may be used as a safe harbor for such determinations.
- BABA requirements apply to TxCDBG grants awarded on or after September 1, 2023, as identified in the grant agreement Special Conditions.

## **Annual Reporting**

TDA is currently preparing multiple annual reports to ensure the program's federal compliance:

- Minority Business Enterprise Report:
  - Please complete Materials and Services Report in TDA-GO for all contracts procured (awarded by local governing body) on or before 9/30/2024.
  - These reports should be submitted by Friday, October 25.
  - If the MSR cannot be submitted by this date, the grant administrator must enter all
    procurement and vendor information by this date you may include a note that the complete
    MSR submittal is pending execution of the vendor contract, for example.
- Acquisition of Real Property Report:
  - For any parcel of real property acquired on or before 9/30/2024, please complete the Acquired Parcel page of the TDA-GO Acquisition Performance Report.

- This report must be completed by Friday, October 25.
- Single Audit Reports (OCSAR) for FY 2024
  - TDA identified communities that are required to report their compliance with federal Single Audit requirements.
  - An OCSAR report has been created in TDA-GO for these communities. (Note: the fiscal year date is currently being entered by TDA staff for each OCSAR – if your FYE date has changed, or if the reported date is incorrect, please email CDBGReporting@TexasAgriculture.gov.)
  - The OCSAR is due nine months after the community's fiscal year end date for communities that did not meet the threshold to require a Single Audit for this fiscal year, TDA encourages submitting the OCSAR to confirm this information as soon as possible.
  - Individuals authorized to certify Payment Requests should have access to complete the OCSAR.
- Facility and Equipment Report (OFE) for 2024
  - For communities with completed projects that included construction of new community buildings, purchase of vehicles, or purchase of other equipment identified in a grant agreement special condition requiring reporting, the annual OFE Report has been created in TDA-GO.
  - The OFE must be submitted no later than **December 31**, **2024**.
  - Individuals authorized to certify Payment Requests should have access to complete the OCSAR.
